

Sports Premium 2017 – 2018



What is Sports Premium?

The government is providing additional funding to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding is provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport and will be allocated to primary school Headteachers.

Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer.

This means that you should use the premium to:

- Develop or add to the PE and sport activities that your school already offers.
- Make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years.

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Expenditure	Details and expected impact	Cost
Competition SLA from Sedgfield Sports Partnership (SSP)	To allow access for all pupils to access a wide range of competitive events and opportunities to participate in different festivals with their peers including gymnastics, dance, cross-country, football, tag rugby, athletics, cricket, tennis and basketball. The competition SLA will also include multi-skills tournaments – this will allow for the children who do not normally compete to participate in events against local schools.	£1500
Bespoke SLA Package from Sedgfield Sports Partnership (SSP)	A bespoke package designed to cater for the individual needs of our school. The package will include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Disability Sports Package – SSP staff will deliver a day of disability sports in school including boccia, new age curling, goal ball and sitting volleyball. - Leadership Package for Children – a group of ten children in school will complete the Sports Leader Playmaker Award, a national certificate for sports leadership. - Judo Taster Session – linked to local club ensuring that community links to clubs are in place. - Gifted and Talented Package – opportunity for six children from Years 5 and 6 to take part in a centralised programme where they can experience a range of sports delivered by high quality coaches. 	£1435.25

Bespoke SLA from Sedgfield Sports Partnership (SSP) 15 hours of Specialist PE Teacher	Support from the SSP will include 2 x ½ days sessions to support the PE Co-ordinator, upskilling PE Co-ordinator with core tasks and assessments in preparation for whole school CPD and ½ whole school CPD on core tasks and assessment.	£759
Bespoke SLA from Sedgfield Sports Partnership (SSP) 15 hours of Coaching	Provides pupils with 15 hours of specialised coaching – focussed on net and wall games, striking and fielding, invasion and OAA games.	£474.50
Bespoke SLA from Sedgfield Sports Partnership (SSP) Taster Session Programme	3 x half day taster sessions linked to local community clubs. This will involve the local community clubs delivering sessions to year groups where their club has a team/session for to encourage children to transition from School Sport to Community Sport.	£316.25
Bespoke SLA from Sedgfield Sports Partnership (SSP) CPD Courses	10 CPD courses provided for staff members to improve staff understanding in all areas of the PE curriculum including, subject leader modules, core task introduction, dance, gymnastics, invasion games, EYFS, OAA and athletics.	£1200
Specialised Sports Coach Focus – Dance and Gymnastics	Deployment qualified sports coaches in dance and gymnastics to work with teachers on Monday afternoon. All teachers to have access to this over the course of the year. Coach to arrange dance and gymnastics festivals in school to display the work to other children and parents.	£2485
Sports Apprentice	To support the teaching of PE across the school. Running lunchtime activities to engage a wide variety of pupils in a number of different sports. To work alongside the PE Co-ordinator to aid the running of intra school competitions. To support staff in running inter school festivals and competition – trials, extra training clubs and support at the events.	£5460
Transport	Buses to be used to allow children to be transported to festivals and tournaments.	£2000
Supply Costs	Supply teacher to cover classes when the teachers are on CPD courses. (½ day cover = £95. 10 CPD courses).	£950
Equipment	Needed in order to deliver a diverse, inspiring and engaging PE curriculum. Purchase of running vests, school kit and hoodies to be worn by teams competing in SSP festivals and competitions. Regular update for break and lunch time equipment – equipment can often be lost and damaged due to daily use. Kit for Sports Apprentice.	£2200
