Activity	<p>Talk about jumping:</p> <p>How far can you jump?</p> <p>Try different jumps e.g 2 feet to 2 feet, 1 foot to 2 feet, 2 feet to 1 foot.</p> <p>Measure how far they can jump, from the same position each time.</p> <p>Try a running jump. Can you jump further now?</p> <p>Keep practising</p> <p>Challenge: if you have a measuring tape, you could measure and record how far they jump each time.</p> <p>You could see if they can beat their distance each time.</p>	<p>Even though the snail is small, he helps to save the whale.</p> <p>Think about your abilities.</p> <p>Is there anything that you thought you couldn't do, but you managed to when you tried?</p>	<p>The whale sang a song to the snail.</p> <p>Could you write the words to the song, or make up a tune for it?</p>	<p>Can you draw your own seaside picture?</p> <p>Can you draw a picture of what lives under the sea?</p> <p>Use google/books to find out some creatures that live in the sea.</p>	<p>The human activity makes the whale swim too close to the shore.</p> <p>Can you find out when this might have happened to real whales in the past?</p> <p>Discuss what we might be able to do to stop it from happening again.</p> <p>You could talk about pollution and how it affects wildlife.</p> <p>Talk about the importance of recycling.</p>
