What would the other snails have said to him would you go if you were him? What could the snail do to help the whale? Why was he so determined to help? What would you do if you were the snail? How will the story end?</p> <p>Read/watch to the end.</p>	<p>Visualisation and drawing Reread the first few pages to the children until the point when the whale appears. Ask the children to close their eyes and visualise the scene the whale describes: ‘Who sang to the whale a wonderful song <i>Of shimmering ice and coral caves</i> And shooting stars and enormous waves’ Look at the describing words- shimmering ice, coral caves. Can ch describe the pictures- the pink and green coral glimmered, the enormous blue wave crashed etc</p> <p>Describing words: e.g blue, silver, white etc Beautiful, calm, gentle, deep, wavy.</p> <p>Challenge: Can they draw a picture from their favourite part of the story?</p> <p>Can they use describing words in their sentences?</p>	<p>Read/watch the story again and ask your child to retell it in their own words.</p> <p>Activity: retell the story in your own words.</p> <p>Draw pictures if this will help.</p>	<p>Find out about whales and/or snails and write some facts about them.</p> <p>Use google or books.</p>
