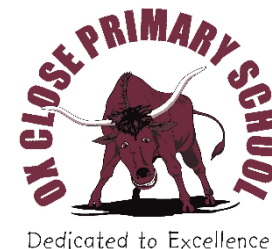


## English Planning and Ideas

<b>Area of Learning</b>	LC: Can you use adjectives to describe a character?	LC: Can you say how a character is feeling and what they are thinking?	LC: Can you write a sentence using a conjunction?	LC: Can you write questions?	LC: Can you describe your favourite foods?
<b>Activity</b>	<p>With an adult, read the story The Mouse, The Frog and The Little Red Hen. Try to sound out any words that you find tricky and ask an adult to help you read any that you can't read yourself.</p> <p>Who are the characters in the story? What are the characters like? How would you describe them?</p> <p>Look at the set of character describing words. Read each carefully and ask for help if you are stuck. Copy each word under the name of the animal that the description goes with. Can you add any of your own adjectives?</p> <p>Challenge: Write a sentence to describe each character using one of the chosen adjectives.</p>	<p>Think carefully about the story The Mouse, The Frog and The Little Red Hen.</p> <p>In the story the Hen is doing all of the hard work and the mouse and frog are both being lazy.</p> <p>What do you think the Hen is thinking?</p> <p>What do you think the Hen is feeling?</p> <p>Add some ideas to the bubbles around the picture of the hard working hen.</p> <p>Eg: in the thinking bubble you could write "I wish those two would help me with some jobs." And in the feeling bubble you could write "I'm so tired and upset."</p>	<p>Think carefully about the story The Mouse, The Frog and The Little Red Hen.</p> <p>Think of all the hard working things that the Hen does in the story.</p> <p>Now think about the things that Mouse and Frog do while Hen is so busy.</p> <p>On the sheet provided, draw Hen doing one of the jobs under the heading 'busy' and then write a sentence about what she is doing. Can you use 'and' to join two ideas together?</p> <p>Under the heading 'lazy' draw mouse and frog doing something and write another sentence using 'and' to describe what they are doing.</p> <p>Challenge: Think about something that you could do to help out at home. Make a list of ideas and ask an adult if you could do some of them to help.</p>	<p>Look at the set of question words. Try to read each word aloud. In many of the question words the h is silent to we don't say it as we read them. Can you have a go at spelling each of the question words?</p> <p>On the sheet provided, write some questions from Hen, Frog or Mouse eg: When will Frog and Mouse help me? Why are you being so lazy? What are you going to eat?</p> <p>Remember to use a capital letter at the start of your sentence and a question mark at the end.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write a reply to your questions? Eg: I'll help later. I'm not lazy, I'm just relaxing. I'll eat the bread.</p>	<p>In the story from Monday, the Hen makes bread and the Mouse and the Frog want to eat it.</p> <p>What foods do you like to eat?</p> <p>Think of 4 different things you like to eat. Why do you like them?</p> <p>Draw a picture of the 4 foods you have chosen and write a sentence about why you like them. Can you use a conjunction in your sentence?</p>
