SSP (School Sports Partnership)

- Provision of festivals, competitions and events to compete against other schools.
- A variety of CPD provided for a staff across different areas of the school.
- Specialist support for PE coordinator.
- Curriculum coaching – working with staff help them plan and teach lessons and increase confidence.
- After school club provision taught by specialist coaches.
- Leadership training for a selected group of upper KS2 children to achieve a special award and to lead a whole school event.
- Physical Activity Club after school club.
- Data from competitions and events recorded in order for Subject Leader to analyse.
- Attendance at Subject Leader Meetings and Network Meetings.

Mr Football

- Provision of Basic Fundamental Movement Skills for all Reception Children.
- Support and intervention for motor difficulties in KS1.
- Popular after-school clubs and holiday clubs.
- CPD and Staff training.

South Durham Gym Club (Pink Gym)

- Provision and specialist coaching in a world-class setting.
- All KS1 children to attend (each class on a weekly basis) and some KS2 children to attend.

Sports Apprentice

- Raising the profile of PE in school.
- Leading the School Sports Organising Crew as well as the 'Young Leaders' (children who lead sport on a yard at lunchtime).
- Offer specialist support for staff teaching PE
- Sporting interventions in PE lessons with more or less able children.
