| <b>Activity</b>         | <p>Think carefully about all of the different parts of your body. You have a head, arms, feet and lots of other parts.<br/>Can you draw a body and label the body parts?</p> <p>Perhaps you could make labels from paper and stick them to your own body.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write a sentence to describe something that each part of your body can do?<br/>Eg My feet can be used for kicking a football. My arms can be used to carry things</p> | <p>Think carefully about your body again. How do you look after it? What does it need? When you feel poorly, what do you do to feel better?</p> <p>Can you think of some ways to stay safe and healthy and make a poster to show your ideas?</p> <p>You could draw, label or write your ideas. Eg I eat fruit and vegetables to stay healthy. They all live in different habitats. Which animal is your favourite?<br/>Do you know where it lives?</p> <p>Draw and label or write sentences about your favourite animal. Can you talk about it with an adult or write down some facts about it?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write some ideas about how we could help protect your chosen animal?</p> | <p>Have a look through your books at home. Can you find any stories about animals?</p> <p>Read the story with an adult and talk about what is happening in the story. You can use the pictures to help you talk about the characters and their actions.</p> <p>Can you tell an adult your favourite part of the story?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write a book review? Write some sentences to describe the story and whether you would recommend it to a friend.</p> |
