Make a Vampire Page Corner Bookmark



You will need:

- bookmark template
- glue
- scissors

Make a vampire page corner bookmark and never lose your place in a book again.



1 Neatly, cut around the edge of the template.



2 Fold the paper in half, using fold line one, to make a triangle – you should be able to see the vampire's eyes once you've done this.



3 Turn the triangle over so that you can see fold lines two, three and four.



4 Fold the left and right corners to the centre of the triangle.



5 Reopen the corners and fold the top corner down along fold line 4 (just the top layer of paper) so that it touches the middle of the bottom edge of the paper.

Make a Vampire Page Corner Bookmark



6 Use fold line two to refold the paper again, but this time, tuck the blank section down the back of the face design. Do this again with fold line three, before making sure your bookmark is flat.



7 Cut out the extra details from the template page and stick them to the bookmark to bring your vampire to life!

Glue the hair above the eyebrows, stick the cape on the back (you should only be able to see the edges poking out at each side), glue on the triangular mouth section and finish with the fangs, which need to be stuck under the top lip section.

Top Tip

Make sure the glue has fully dried before using your bookmark in a book!
