Activity	<p>Now we are going to be looking at the land use of our school grounds. Last week we looked at our school campus and how it is made up.</p> <p>Today we will be creating a key for our land use around school.</p> <p>Think of colours and symbols that we will use for our key – eg learning space, nature, self-care etc.</p> <p><u>Your task today:</u></p> <p>Look at your map from last week and colour it in according to the key you have designed. Next add your symbols according to the key also.</p>	<p>Today we will be looking at maps of larger areas of the country and what information we can infer from these maps.</p> <p>There are two types of land use – urban and rural. We will be learning about these two terms today and will discover how to classify different types of land use as rural or urban.</p> <p><u>Your task today:</u></p> <p>Complete your land use maps of the UK – choose your own level of challenge (1-3 stars).</p>	<p>We are going to be focusing our learning today around the rural element of land use.</p> <p>The UK has a large proportion of rural land use which can be split up into different categories.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Agriculture ■ Forestry ■ Coastal ■ Freshwater ■ Protected Land <p><u>Your task today:</u></p> <p>Look at a topological map of the UK and complete your worksheet (these are 1-3 stars, you can choose your level of challenge).</p>	<p>THE BIG QUESTIONS</p> <p>-What kinds of people live in the British Isles? -What is it like to live in the British Isles?</p> <p>Discuss some of the images and how they represent diversity.</p> <p>Let's discuss what we mean by the British Isles and where we live.
